WELCOME & THANK YOU FOR JOINING US AS WE RELEASE THE 2018 NUCLEAR POSTURE REVIEW, OR 'NPR.'

TO THE AMERICAN PEOPLE: THIS ADMINISTRATION'S HIGHEST PRIORITY IS YOUR SAFETY & SECURITY.

ONE YEAR AGO, WE BEGAN A FOCUSED, COMPREHENSIVE LOOK AT WHAT WE NEEDED TO MEET THIS FUNDAMENTAL RESPONSIBILITY.

IT STARTED WITH PRESIDENT TRUMP'S NATIONAL SECURITY STRATEGY.

IN SUPPORT, SECRETARY MATTIS LED THE DEVELOPMENT OF OUR NATIONAL DEFENSE STRATEGY.

BOTH STATE THE NEED FOR A <u>SAFE</u>, <u>SECURE</u>, <u>EFFECTIVE</u> NUCLEAR DETERRENT.

THIS REVIEW IS <u>CONSISTENT</u> WITH U.S. NUCLEAR POLICIES SINCE THE END OF THE COLD WAR.

IT REAFFIRMS <u>THAT</u> THE FUNDAMENTAL ROLE OF U.S. NUCLEAR POLICY IS <u>DETERRENCE</u> & <u>CONTINUES OUR CLEAR COMMITMENT TO NON-PROLIFERATION</u> & <u>ARMS CONTROL</u>.

THE CHALLENGING & DYNAMIC SECURITY ENVIRONMENT REQUIRES STEADY ACTION TO STRENGTHEN DETERRENCE.

THIS NPR RESPONDS TO <u>TODAY'S</u> SECURITY NEEDS WITH A TAILORED NUCLEAR DETERRENT STRATEGY...

AND FLEXIBLE CAPABILITIES FOR <u>EFFECTIVE</u> DETERRENCE. A "ONE-SIZE FITS ALL" APPROACH HAS ITS LIMITS.

THIS NPR ENSURES WE CAN DETER <u>ANY</u> POTENTIAL ADVERSARY, BECAUSE THEY ARE NOT ALL ALIKE.

WE MUST KEEP AMERICA'S DETERRENT CREDIBLE BY MAKING IT MODERN.

THE 2018 NPR CALLS FOR MODERNIZING THE NUCLEAR TRIAD & COMMAND & CONTROL SYSTEM – WHICH IS <u>NECESSARY</u>, <u>AFFORDABLE</u> & <u>LONG OVER-DUE</u>.

OUR NUCLEAR TRIAD HAS KEPT US SAFE FOR MORE THAN 70 YEARS
 WE CANNOT AFFORD TO LET IT BECOME OBSOLETE

THE NPR ALSO MAKES <u>RECOMMENDATIONS</u> TO KEEP OUR DETERRENT EFFECTIVE FOR OUR WORLD TODAY, NAMELY:

- LOWERING THE YIELD OF SOME EXISTING SUBMARINE-LAUNCHED BALLISTIC MISSILE WARHEADS
- AND BRINGING BACK A NUCLEAR SEA-LAUNCHED CRUISE MISSILE, A CAPABILITY OUR NATION HAD FOR DECADES

NEITHER RECOMMENDATION REQUIRES DEVELOPING NEW NUCLEAR WARHEADS.

NEITHER WILL INCREASE THE SIZE OF OUR NUCLEAR STOCKPILE.

THEY BREAK NO TREATY.

THEY ALIGN WITH OUR NON-PROLIFERATION COMMITMENTS. THEY STRENGTHEN AMERICAN DETERRENCE.

SOME WILL SAY ANY ADDITIONAL CAPABILITY,

NO MATTER HOW MEASURED,

INCREASES THE CHANCES OF USING ONE OF THESE WEAPONS.

ON THE CONTRARY - IT IS THE EXACT OPPOSITE.

THE NPR STATES: "THE UNITED STATES WOULD ONLY CONSIDER THE USE OF NUCLEAR WEAPONS IN EXTREME CIRCUMSTANCES TO DEFEND THE VITAL INTERESTS OF THE UNITED STATES, ITS ALLIES & PARTNERS."

THE NPR CLARIFIES LONGSTANDING POLICY THAT "EXTREME CIRCUMSTANCES" COULD INCLUDE SIGNIFICANT NON-NUCLEAR STRATEGIC ATTACKS.

THIS CLARIFICATION IS STABILIZING. IT LOWERS THE RISK OF NUCLEAR USE BY ANYONE.

THE UNITED STATES DOES NOT WANT TO USE NUCLEAR WEAPONS.

WE <u>DO</u> WANT TO <u>MAINTAIN AN EFFECTIVE DETERRENT</u> TO KEEP AMERICANS & OUR ALLIES & PARTNERS SAFE & SECURE.

UNDER-SECRETARY SHANNON WILL SPEAK TO OUR NPR ENGAGEMENT WITH ALLIES & PARTNERS.

BUT BEFORE HE DOES, I WANT TO THANK THE MEN & WOMEN OF OUR NUCLEAR FORCES.

YOUR DEDICATION KEEPS AMERICA SAFE.

WE LOOK FORWARD TO WORKING WITH CONGRESS AS WE IMPLEMENT THESE RECOMMENDATIONS...

AND FOR ON-GOING SUPPORT FOR NUCLEAR MODERNIZATION.

WE ALSO LOOK FORWARD TO WORKING WITH OUR ALLIES & PARTNERS TO REDUCE THE CHANCES THAT THESE WEAPONS WILL EVER BE USED.
